LEADERSHIP ACADEMY PURPOSE

To build a diverse pool of academic & staff employees with the knowledge and skills to be successful in leadership roles at UCSC

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

Staff employees (Senior Analyst PSS K – MSP V or equivalent), with a minimum of six months of service, and Senate faculty are eligible to participate. Continuing lecturers may apply and will be accepted into the Academy if space permits.

OVERVIEW

The Leadership Academy will meet over a three-month period, from January through March 2014. Each session will highlight specific issues and challenges faced by UCSC leaders. Through presentation, discussion and experiential learning, participants will broaden their understanding of how UCSC operates and hone their leadership skills and abilities. The Academy provides a unique opportunity for cross-campus networking, and for dialogue with the Chancellor, Executive Vice Chancellor, and other campus leaders. There is no fee to participate.
